



General Guidelines

1. Registrations for all the management events will be closed by 12.00 PM on October 11th, 2023.
2. Spot registration for Group Dance, FIFA Gaming Event, Photography, and Treasure Hunt will be closed by 09:00 AM on October 13th, 2023 (First Day) and for Spot Dance, 3's Football, and Corporate Walk will be closed by 08:30 AM on October 14th, 2023 (Final Day)
3. Registration is mandatory for participating in any event either via online or spot registration (for certain events). However, to complete the process, the participant must pay the registration fees and collect their badge in person from the registration counters located at the venue.
4. Registration must be done at least 1 hour before the start of each event.
5. The management events are open to both PG and UG students of any stream and for all professional courses.

6. Only one member of a team needs to register for team events. One person per team must be there to act as a point of contact for each team (like a team manager).
 7. The College ID Card or the authorization letter from the college authority (in case ID cards are not issued) for each participant should be provided as a PDF file during the registration process. All participants are required to always carry their respective college ID cards within the college premises.
 8. There is no limit to the number of participants/teams from a specific college for any event.
 9. All the members of a team should be from the same college/institute. Modifications concerning the teams will not be permitted after registration.
 10. The committee has the right to modify or amend the event schedule or platform of the events at any point in time if the situation demands it. In case of any unforeseen circumstance, the committees have the sole authority to make decisions.

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11. The participants must report to the venue 30 minutes before the commencement of their respective events. Teams failing to report at the specific venue at the stipulated time will be disqualified.
 12. A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timings for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timings do not clash.
 13. All the events will commence at the scheduled time; Punctuality will be appreciated.
 14. Participants should carry laptops (at least two), Net setters, Calculators, good quality video recording devices (mobile phones/video cameras), and Pen Drives for their personal use.
 15. Writing materials and other stationery items will be provided by the college.
 16. The phone number provided by the candidate during the time of registration will be used for any further communications.

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17. Each event will have a specific set of rules and regulations. Participants are expected to go through all and adhere to the same.
 18. Participants of management events should come prepared to stay overnight on the campus on the first day if selected for further rounds on day 2.
 19. The decisions taken by the committees and the judges would be final in any circumstance.
 20. All file submissions like documents, pictures, videos, audio, and PPTs should be done in the prescribed format itself. Delayed submissions will not be entertained.
 21. Plagiarism checks may be done at any point in time and would further result in disqualification if found guilty.
 22. Privacy of the links provided during the events must be respected. It should not be shared or forwarded unless specified.

23. Any sort of unfair/unethical practice or violation of rules will be treated seriously and may further lead to the disqualification of the participant/team.
 24. The organizers will have complete rights over any content presented/shared by the participants during the event.
 25. Participants are advised to take care of their belongings. Organizers will not be held responsible for any damage or loss.
 26. Students should refrain from abusive language and obscene displays during the competitions, failing which they will be disqualified.
 27. Smoking, drinking, and consumption of any such 'substances' are prohibited. Participants violating this rule will be disqualified and restricted from the events.
 28. All participants will be provided with a softcopy of participation certificates.

1. A team must consist of 4 members.
2. The students of one team can only be a part of a single team

1. A team must consist of 4 members.
2. The students of one team can only be a part of a single team.

1. A team must consist of 4 members.
2. The students of one team can only be a part of a single team.

3. Enable drive access to the event email id (analytics-gameinflore@rajagiri.edu) for every submission throughout the event.

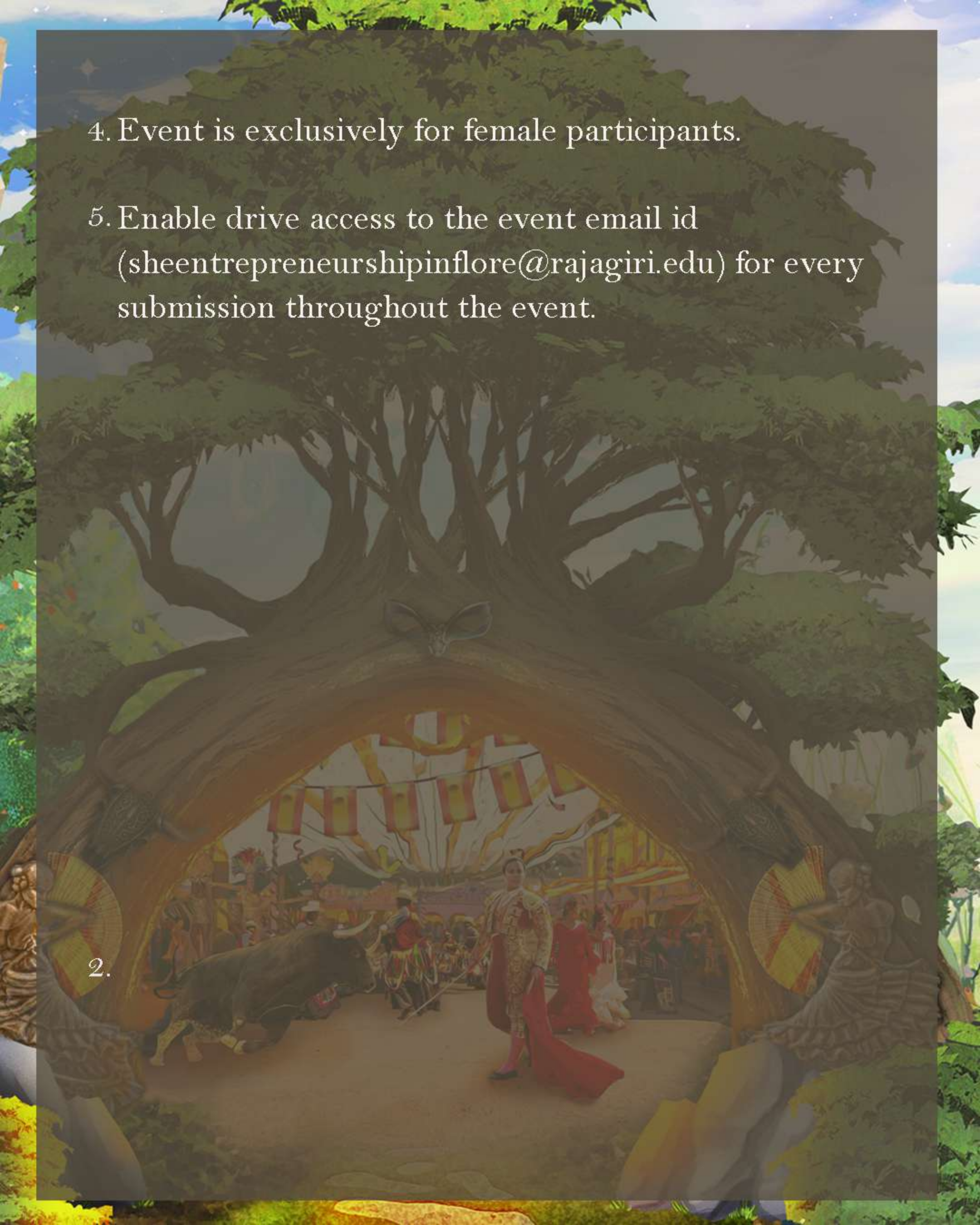
Emprendedoras Valientes - She Entrepreneurship Game

submission throughout the event.

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
Non Management Events

Danza en el Foco – Spot Dance

1. It is an Individual event.
2. Any style of dance is accepted.
3. There will be four rounds, instructions for which will be given separately, prior to the event.
4. The costumes of the participants should be neat and decent. No vulgarity is promoted.
5. Use of hazardous materials on stage is prohibited.

Baile en Grupo – Group Dance

1. Every group must have a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 15 members.
2. Choice of the song is open to the participants.

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3. The music provided by the participants must be audible enough.
 4. The costume of the participant must be neat and decent, no vulgarity will be entertained.
 5. All types of dance forms like hip-hop, contemporary, classical, folk, jazz, etc., are allowed.
 6. There will be only 1 round, the instruction of which would be given prior to the event.
 7. Song duration must be within 7 to 10 minutes and an extra 3 minutes will be given for setting up the stage.
 8. Use of hazardous materials on stage is prohibited.


Canta España – Voice Of Infloré

1. It is a solo singing competition.
2. No repetition of songs is permitted in different rounds.

3. No chorus voices are allowed in karaoke.
4. Songs with pure and proper language usage must be selected, and for the western category, rap versions are not allowed.
5. Participants are required to use either karaoke or a musical instrument played by themselves.
6. Karaoke tracks if any should be submitted prior to the start of the event on a CD/DVD/PENDRIVE.
7. Enable drive access to the event email id (voiceofin-floreinflore@rajagiri.edu) for every submission throughout the event.

Caza del Tesoro – Treasure Hunt


1. A team should consist of four members.
2. Participants should reach back to the venue at the stipulated time of each round end. Teams that do not return within the given time will be disqualified.

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3. Teams must be present for each round briefing which is half an hour before the round commences. Absence can lead to disqualification.
 4. People with health issues are advised not to participate, as different types of tasks are involved in the event.
 5. Suggest participants to wear comfortable clothes as they have to do tasks.
 6. Team members participating in the treasure hunt will not be allowed to participate in other events happening on the same day.
 7. Enable drive access to the event email id (treasure-huntinflore@rajagiri.edu) for every submission throughout the event.


Fotografia Arte – Photography


Mobile Photography

1. It is an individual event.
2. All the participants must carry their college ID card.

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3. There will be two rounds, both theme-based.
 4. Judgement will be based on creativity, adherence to the theme, composition, color, lighting, and the impact of the submitted work.
 5. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
 6. Online registration will be closed one day prior to the event.
 7. Spot registration will be open and closed one hour prior to the event.


Reel Making

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1. Individual as well as group entries (not more than 3 people) are allowed.
 2. All the participants must carry their college ID cards.

 4. The video should not exceed 60 seconds in portrait mode.
 5. Usage of tools like Gimbal, lightning equipment, macro lens etc are allowed.
 6. Use of unfair means and violation of rules can lead to disqualification.
 7. Judgement will be based on creativity, adherence to the theme, composition, visual appeal, narrative, and the production quality of the submitted work.
 8. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
 9. Online registration will be closed one day prior to the event.
 10. Spot registration will be open and closed one hour prior to the event.


- * Images should not be larger than 20 MB for Mobile photography.
- * All submitted photos must contain the original EXIF metadata information.
- * There must be no border(s), logo(s), copyright marks, identifying marks, or any other visible references and/or marks on the image.
- * Participants are requested to provide information about their equipment along with the registration form fill up for ensuring the authenticity of ownership of the still.
- * Photos that portray or otherwise include inappropriate and/or offensive content, including provocative nudity, violence, human rights and/or environmental violation, and/or any other contents deemed to be contrary to the law, religious, cultural & moral traditions, and practices of India, are strictly prohibited and will be immediately discarded.

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- * The submitted photograph must be original, owned by the participant, and should in no way violate intellectual property rights. If any of the pictures stand as a reason for the breach of ownership issue of other intellectual property rights, the event will not be responsible for the behaviour of each participant and appropriate legal actions will be taken.


Copa Triunfo - 3'S Football

1. Team size: a total of 5 members (3 players + 2 rolling substitutes).
2. Participants should carry their own football kit.
3. Proper football kit is mandatory in order to avoid injury.
4. Match time is 10 minutes with 2 minutes half time in between.

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5. Use of unfair means or violation of any rules will lead to disqualification. The decision of the referee will be final.


Ecos de Elegancia – Corporate Walk

1. Each team can have minimum of 7 and maximum 15 members.
2. The time limit for the event is 15 minutes of ramp (including the setting up of stage) and 3 minutes for questions and answers.
3. The fashion show does not follow any particular theme. It is an Open Theme event.
4. Background narration is allowed.
5. Background music and backdrops (if any) must be submitted in Google Drive prior to the event.
6. The teams are not allowed to exhibit their themes explicitly through banners, posters, or materials directly.

Liga Fifa - Fifa Gaming Event

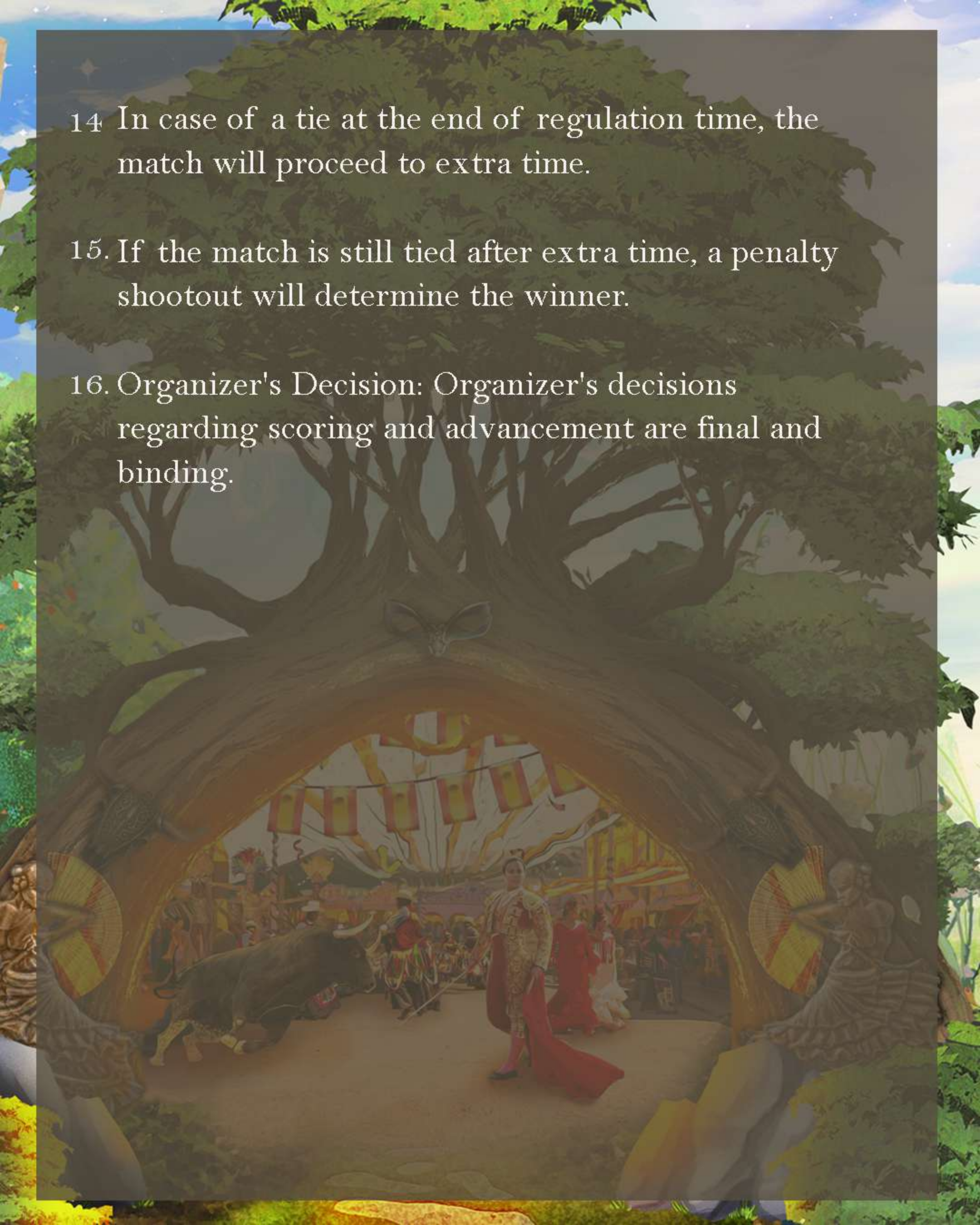
1. Game Platform: PlayStation4 / PlayStation5 with controllers.
2. Game Duration: Each game will last 10 minutes (5 minutes per half).
3. "Competitive master switch" will be ON.
4. "Legacy Defending" won't be allowed.

 8. Camera angles can be changed if both contestants agree.
 9. All other game settings will be set to default.
 10. Participants must use provided controllers.
 11. Tournament will be played on EA FC 2024.
 12. Team Selection: Certain teams are banned from selection (Adidas All-Star, MLS All-Stars, Soccer Aid, All Women's Teams, and All International Teams).
 13. Registration Requirements: Players must bring an ID proof for registration, and any violation will result in invalid registration.

14 In case of a tie at the end of regulation time, the match will proceed to extra time.

15. If the match is still tied after extra time, a penalty shootout will determine the winner.

16. Organizer's Decision: Organizer's decisions regarding scoring and advancement are final and binding.
